FAMILY REGISTRATION FORM

A Family Registration Form must be on file before you can register family members for programs.

ONLINE

Access to online registration is available to year round residents with "Log In" privileges on our website. The process to receive "Log In" privileges is as follows: Return a Family Registration Form with an e-mail address. Staff will verify residency requirements have been met. Call or let us know you wish to have access to online registration. Staff will send you an e-mail with instructions for setting up an online account that will allow you to log in to purchase programs with a credit card.

Please register early. Some classes/programs have a maximum enrollment and fill quickly. Others have a minimum enrollment which must be met at least 5 business days prior to the start of class to avoid cancellation. We will make every effort to notify you if a class is cancelled due to low enrollment.

PAYMENT

Full payment must accompany all registration forms. We will return your check if a class or program is full or cancelled.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Because our classes are self supporting, we can only offer limited scholarships. Our goal is to keep prices as low as possible, hopefully making classes affordable to everyone. If you have a financial problem which will prohibit participation, particularly for your children, please give us a call. We will work with you to find a solution.

REFUNDS

Requests for refunds must be received a least five business days before the start of a class or program. Otherwise we will not offer a refund. **There will be a \$5.00 processing fee per class for each refund.** Please be sure to sign up for the classes you really want.

NOTIFICATION POLICY

You will not receive confirmation of program registration unless a program needs to be changed or cancelled. Please keep this brochure handy for program dates and times, and plan to arrive for your program at the scheduled date and time unless otherwise notified.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

If you or someone in your family is registered for a program that ordinarily takes places outdoors, please exercise your best judgment when there is inclement weather. If at all possible the program will meet as normal. However, in severe weather conditions that make it impossible to play that activity, that program will be cancelled.
